## A BILL

To prohibit the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission from issuing certain decisions that will raise costs for ratepayers, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION AGAINST CERTAIN FERC DECI-**  
4                               **SIONS THAT WILL RAISE COSTS FOR RATE-**  
5                               **PAYERS.**

6       (a) COST-BENEFIT ANALYSIS.—Prior to issuing a de-  
7       cision described in subsection (b), the Federal Energy  
8       Regulatory Commission shall publish a cost-benefit anal-  
9       ysis of such decision, including the likely financial impact  
10      of such decision on ratepayers.

1 (b) DECISIONS.—This section applies to any decision  
2 by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission that will—

3 (1) authorize the creation of a new capacity  
4 zone; or

5 (2) affect the supply and demand curves or  
6 models used to determine prices at points in a ca-  
7 pacity zone.

8 (c) PROHIBITION.—If the Federal Energy Regulatory  
9 Commission determines, through a cost-benefit analysis  
10 published under subsection (a), that a decision described  
11 in subsection (b) will raise costs for ratepayers, then the  
12 Commission may not issue such decision.

13 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This section takes effect on  
14 January 1, 2014.
