2 **CARE, MEDICAL SERVICES, AND NURSING**
3 **HOME AND DOMICILIARY CARE FOR CERTAIN**
4 **VETERANS WHO SERVED IN A THEATER OF**
5 **COMBAT OPERATIONS.**

7 Code, is amended by striking “period of five years” and
8 inserting “period of 10 years”.
