SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2	This Act may be cited as the "Fiscal Year 2023 Vet-
3	erans Affairs Major Medical Facility Authorization Act".
4	SEC. 2. AUTHORIZATION OF MAJOR MEDICAL FACILITY
5	PROJECTS OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS
6	AFFAIRS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023.
7	(a) In General.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
8	may carry out the following major medical facility projects
9	in fiscal year 2023 at the locations specified and in an
10	amount for each project not to exceed the amount speci-
11	fied for such location:
12	(1) Construction of a community-based out-
13	patient clinic and national cemetery in Alameda,
14	California, in an amount not to exceed
15	\$395,000,000.
16	(2) Construction of a community living center
17	and renovation of domiciliary and outpatient facili-
18	ties in Canandaigua, New York, in an amount not
19	to exceed \$506,400,000.
20	(3) Construction of a new health care center in
21	El Paso, Texas, in an amount not to exceed
22	\$700,000,000.
23	(4) Seismic upgrade and specialty care improve-
24	ments in Fort Harrison, Montana, in an amount not
25	to exceed \$88,600,000.

1	(5) Realignment and closure of the Livermore
2	campus in Livermore, California, in an amount not
3	to exceed \$490,000,000.
4	(6) Construction of a new medical facility in
5	Louisville, Kentucky, in an amount not to exceed
6	\$1,013,000,000.
7	(7) Seismic retrofit and renovation, roadway
8	and site improvements, construction of a new spe-
9	cialty care facility, demolition, and expansion of
10	parking facilities in Portland, Oregon, in an amount
11	not to exceed \$523,000,000.
12	(b) Authorization of Appropriations.—There is
13	authorized to be appropriated to the Secretary of Veterans
14	Affairs for fiscal year 2023 or the year in which funds
15	are appropriated for the Construction, Major Projects ac-
16	count, \$3,716,000,000 for the projects authorized in sub-
17	section (a).
