3 **SECTION 1. JOSEPH R. LENTOL POST OFFICE.**

4 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
5 Postal Service located at 66 Meserole Avenue in Brooklyn,
6 New York, shall be known and designated as the “Joseph
7 R. Lentol Post Office”.

8 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
9 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United

1 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
2 be deemed to be a reference to the “Joseph R. Lentol Post
3 Office”.
