## A BILL

To extend the temporary suspension of duty on ion-exchange resins consisting of copolymers of acrylic acid and diethylene glycol divinyl ether.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ION-EXCHANGE RESINS CONSISTING OF CO-**  
4 **POLYMERS OF ACRYLIC ACID AND**  
5 **DIETHYLENE GLYCOL DIVINYL ETHER.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Heading 9902.11.71 of the Har-  
7 monized Tariff Schedule of the United States (relating to  
8 ion-exchange resins consisting of copolymers of acrylic  
9 acid and diethylene glycol divinyl ether) is amended by

1 striking the date in the effective period column and insert-  
2 ing “12/31/2015”.

3 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
4 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or  
5 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
6 the 15th day after the date of the enactment of this Act.
