A BILL

To authorize the extension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal trade relations treatment) to the products of Moldova.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. TERMINATION OF APPLICATION OF TITLE IV

4 OF THE TRADE ACT OF 1974 TO THE PROD-5 UCTS OF MOLDOVA.

6 (a) PRESIDENTIAL DETERMINATIONS AND EXTEN7 SION OF NONDISCRIMINATORY TREATMENT.—Notwith8 standing any provision of title IV of the Trade Act of 1974
9 (19 U.S.C. 2431 et seq.), the President may—

(1) determine that the denial of nondiscrim inatory treatment should no longer apply to the
 products of Moldova; and

4 (2) after making a determination under para5 graph (1) with respect to Moldova, proclaim the ex6 tension of nondiscriminatory treatment (normal
7 trade relations treatment) to the products of
8 Moldova.

9 (b) TERMINATION OF APPLICABILITY OF TITLE 10 IV.—On and after the date on which the President ex-11 tends nondiscriminatory treatment to the products of 12 Moldova pursuant to subsection (a), title IV of the Trade 13 Act of 1974 shall cease to apply to Moldova.
