A BILL

To redesignate the Hulls Cove Visitor Center at Acadia National Park as the “George J. Mitchell, Jr., Visitor Center”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REDESIGNATION OF THE HULLS COVE VISITOR**

4 **CENTER AT ACADIA NATIONAL PARK AS THE**

5 **GEORGE J. MITCHELL, JR., VISITOR CENTER.**

6 (a) REDESIGNATION.—The Hulls Cove Visitor Center
7 at Acadia National Park located in Bar Harbor, Maine,
8 or any successor to that visitor center that is constructed
9 after the date of enactment of this Act and serves as the

1 primary visitor center for Acadia National Park, shall be
2 known and designated as the “George J. Mitchell, Jr., Vis-
3 itor Center”.

4 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
5 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
6 States to the visitor center referred to in subsection (a)
7 shall be deemed to be a reference to the “George J. Mitch-
8 ell, Jr., Visitor Center”.
