A BILL

To repeal an obsolete provision in title 49, United States Code, requiring motor vehicle insurance cost reporting.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL.**

4 Subsection (c) of section 32302 of title 49, United
5 States Code, is repealed, and any regulations promulgated
6 under such subsection shall have no force or effect.

1 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION REGARDING PROVISION OF DAM-**
2 **AGE SUSCEPTIBILITY INFORMATION TO CON-**
3 **SUMERS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 32302(b) of title 49,
5 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the
6 following: “The Secretary, after providing an opportunity
7 for public comment, shall study and report to Congress
8 the most useful data, format, and method for providing
9 simple and understandable damage susceptibility informa-
10 tion to consumers.”.

11 (b) DEADLINE.—The Secretary of Transportation
12 shall carry out the last sentence of section 32302(b) of
13 title 49, United States Code, as added by subsection (a),
14 not later than the date that is 2 years after the date of
15 the enactment of this Act.

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
