A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to require that plain writing statements regarding the solicitation of subcontractors be included in certain subcontracting plans, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Simplifying Subcon-
3 tracting Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. PLAIN WRITING APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR**
5 **SOLICITATION OF SUBCONTRACTORS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8(d) of the Small Busi-
7 ness Act (15 U.S.C. 637(d)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (6)—

9 (A) in subparagraph (H)(ii), by striking
10 “and” at the end;

11 (B) in subparagraph (I)(ii), by striking the
12 period at the end and inserting “; and”; and

13 (C) by adding at the end the following:

14 “(J) a representation that—

15 “(i) the offeror or bidder will communicate
16 all solicitations of subcontracts in plain writing
17 (as defined in section 3 of the Plain Writing
18 Act of 2010 (Public Law 111–274; 124 Stat.
19 2861)) so that the solicitation is easily under-
20 stood by small business concerns seeking to ob-
21 tain a subcontracting opportunity from the of-
22 feror or bidder; and

23 “(ii) the offeror or bidder will include the
24 plain writing requirement described in clause (i)
25 in all subcontracts that offer subcontracting op-
26 portunities.”; and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following:

2 “(18) COMPLIANCE WITH PLAIN WRITING RE-
3 QUIREMENT.—If the Administrator determines that
4 a prime contractor failed to communicate any solici-
5 tation of a subcontract in plain writing in accord-
6 ance with paragraph (6)(J), the prime contractor
7 shall communicate a new solicitation of the sub-
8 contract in plain writing not later than 30 days after
9 the date on which the Administrator made that de-
10 termination.”.

11 (b) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 90 days after the
12 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the
13 Small Business Administration shall promulgate regula-
14 tions to carry out paragraphs (6)(J) and (18) of section
15 8(d) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 637(d)), as
16 added by subsection (a).
