Mr. PORTMAN (for himself and Mr. SCHUMER) introduced the following bill;
which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

To improve the response to missing children and victims
of child sex trafficking.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bringing Missing Chil-
5 dren Home Act of 2015”.

6 **SEC. 2. RESPONSE TO MISSING CHILDREN AND VICTIMS OF**
7 **CHILD SEX TRAFFICKING.**

8 (a) MISSING CHILDREN’S ASSISTANCE ACT.—Section
9 404(b)(1)(P)(iii) of the Missing Children’s Assistance Act

1 (42 U.S.C. 5773(b)(1)(P)(iii)) is amended by striking
2 “child prostitution” and inserting “child sex trafficking”.

3 (b) CRIME CONTROL ACT OF 1990.—Section 3702
4 of the Crime Control Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 5780) is
5 amended—

6 (1) in paragraph (2), by striking “and” at the
7 end;

8 (2) in paragraph (3)—

9 (A) by redesignating subparagraphs (B)
10 and (C) as subparagraphs (C) and (D), respec-
11 tively; and

12 (B) by inserting after subparagraph (A)
13 the following:

14 “(B) a recent photograph of the child, if
15 available;”; and

16 (3) in paragraph (4)—

17 (A) in subparagraph (A), by striking “60
18 days” and inserting “30 days”;

19 (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking
20 “and” at the end;

21 (C) in subparagraph (C)—

22 (i) by inserting “State and local child
23 welfare systems and” before “the National
24 Center for Missing and Exploited Chil-
25 dren”; and

1 (ii) by striking the period at the end
2 and inserting “; and”; and

3 (D) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(D) grant permission to the National
5 Crime Information Center Terminal Contractor
6 for the State to update the missing person
7 record in the National Crime Information Cen-
8 ter computer networks with additional informa-
9 tion learned during the investigation relating to
10 the missing person.”.
