3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Religious
5 Freedom for Foster Families Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON RULEMAKING.**

2 The Secretary of Health and Human Services may
3 not finalize, implement, or enforce the proposed rule, enti-
4 tled “Safe and Appropriate Foster Care Placement Re-
5 quirements for Titles IV–E and IV–B” (88 Fed. Reg.
6 66752; published September 28, 2023), or any substan-
7 tially similar rule.
