## A BILL

To appropriate funds to U.S. Customs and Border Protection for the deployment of nonintrusive inspection technology at the southern land border of the United States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Deploy Fentanyl Scan-  
5 ners Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. APPROPRIATION OF AMOUNTS TO INSTALL NON-**  
2 **INTRUSIVE INSPECTION TECHNOLOGY AT**  
3 **THE SOUTHERN BORDER.**

4       There are appropriated, out of any money in the  
5 Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to U.S. Customs  
6 and Border Protection \$201,000,000 for fiscal year 2024  
7 for the deployment of nonintrusive inspection technology  
8 at the southern land border of the United States.
