A BILL

To extend the period for obligations or expenditures for amounts obligated for the National Disaster Resilience competition.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION FOR USE OF AMOUNTS OBLIGATED**
4 **FOR NATIONAL DISASTER RESILIENCE COM-**
5 **PETITION.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Funds made available in title VIII
7 of the Disaster Relief Appropriations Act, 2013 (division
8 A of Public Law 113–2) under the heading “COMMUNITY
9 DEVELOPMENT FUND” under the heading “DEPARTMENT

1 OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT” that were allo-
2 cated pursuant to the National Disaster Resilience com-
3 petition and that were available for obligation through fis-
4 cal year 2017 and for expenditure through fiscal year
5 2022 are to remain available through fiscal year 2025 for
6 the liquidation of valid obligations incurred in fiscal years
7 2014 through 2017.

8 (b) EMERGENCY REQUIREMENT.—The amount de-
9 scribed in subsection (a) is designated by Congress as
10 being for an emergency requirement pursuant to section
11 251(b)(2)(A)(i) of the Balanced Budget and Emergency
12 Deficit Control Act of 1985 (2 U.S.C. 901(b)(2)(A)(i)).

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
