## A BILL

To repeal the District of Columbia Home Rule Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Bringing Oversight  
5 to Washington and Safety to Every Resident Act” or the  
6 “BOWSER Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA HOME RULE**  
2 **ACT.**

3 Effective on the date that is 1 year after the date  
4 of enactment of this Act, the District of Columbia Home  
5 Rule Act (Public Law 93–198; 87 Stat. 774) is repealed.
