A BILL

To amend the American Indian, Alaska Native, and Native Hawaiian Culture and Art Development Act to modify the program for Native Hawaiian and Alaska Native culture and arts development, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Native Arts and Cul-
5 ture Promotion Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO AMERICAN INDIAN, ALASKA NA-**
2 **TIVE, AND NATIVE HAWAIIAN CULTURE AND**
3 **ART DEVELOPMENT ACT.**

4 Section 1521 of the American Indian, Alaska Native,
5 and Native Hawaiian Culture and Art Development Act
6 (20 U.S.C. 4441) is amended—

7 (1) in subsection (a), in the matter preceding
8 paragraph (1), by striking “private,”; and

9 (2) in subsection (c)—

10 (A) by striking paragraph (2) and insert-
11 ing the following:

12 “(2) For any grants made with respect to Na-
13 tive Hawaiian art and culture, the members of the
14 governing board which is required to be established
15 under paragraph (1) shall—

16 “(A) include Native Hawaiians and indi-
17 viduals widely recognized in the field of Native
18 Hawaiian art and culture; and

19 “(B) serve for a fixed term.”; and

20 (B) in paragraph (3)—

21 (i) in subparagraph (A), by striking
22 the comma at the end and inserting “;
23 and”;

24 (ii) by striking subparagraph (B); and

- 1 (iii) by redesignating subparagraph
- 2 (C) as subparagraph (B).
