## A BILL

To require a study relating to the Minidoka National Historic Site.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. GAO STUDY ON THE MINIDOKA NATIONAL HIS-**  
4 **TORIC SITE.**

5 The Secretary of the Interior may not issue any au-  
6 thorization for the project described in the notice of avail-  
7 ability of the Bureau of Land Management entitled “No-  
8 tice of Availability of the Final Environmental Impact  
9 Statement for the Proposed Lava Ridge Wind Project in  
10 Jerome, Lincoln, and Minidoka Counties, ID” (89 Fed.  
11 Reg. 48681 (June 7, 2024)) (or a substantially similar

1 project) unless and until the date on which the Comp-  
2 troller General of the United States completes a report  
3 identifying potential adverse effects of the project on or  
4 to the Minidoka National Historic Site, wildlife, cultural  
5 resources, transportation, hunting, wetlands, and con-  
6 nected surface water and groundwater.
