3 **SECTION 1. GAO STUDY ON THE MINIDOKA NATIONAL HIS-**
4 **TORIC SITE.**

5 The Secretary of the Interior may not issue any au-
6 thorization for the project described in the notice of avail-
7 ability of the Bureau of Land Management entitled “No-

1 tice of Availability of the Final Environmental Impact
2 Statement for the Proposed Lava Ridge Wind Project in
3 Jerome, Lincoln, and Minidoka Counties, ID” (89 Fed.
4 Reg. 48681 (June 7, 2024)) (or a substantially similar
5 project) unless and until the date on which the Comp-
6 troller General of the United States completes a report
7 identifying potential adverse effects of the project on or
8 to the Minidoka National Historic Site, wildlife, cultural
9 resources, transportation, hunting, wetlands, and con-
10 nected surface water and groundwater.
