A BILL

To prohibit the use of amounts from the Upper Colorado River Basin Fund to implement a certain record of decision, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION OF USE OF AMOUNTS FROM THE**
4 **UPPER COLORADO RIVER BASIN FUND FOR**
5 **CERTAIN PURPOSES.**

6 (a) PROHIBITION.—No amounts from the Upper Col-
7 orado River Basin Fund established by section 5(a) of the
8 Act of April 11, 1956 (commonly known as the “Colorado
9 River Storage Project Act”) (70 Stat. 107, chapter 203;
10 43 U.S.C. 620d(a)), shall be used to implement the record

1 of decision entitled the “Record of Decision for the Glen
2 Canyon Dam Long-Term Experimental and Management
3 Plan Final Environmental Impact Statement” and dated
4 December 2016, as supplemented by the record of decision
5 entitled “Supplement to the 2016 Glen Canyon Dam
6 Long-Term Experimental and Management Plan Record
7 of Decision” and dated July 2024, to address the threat
8 of nonnative fish in the Colorado River below Glen Canyon
9 Dam.

10 (b) TREATMENT OF FUNDS.—Any Federal funds
11 made available for the purpose described in subsection (a)
12 shall be nonreimbursable and nonreturnable to the United
13 States.
