Mr. GRAHAM introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

A BILL

To terminate United States economic and military assistance to any country that recognizes Russia's efforts to annex any part of Ukraine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Ukrainian
5 Sovereignty Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PURPOSE.**

7 The purpose of this Act is to ensure that any country
8 that recognizes the annexation by the Russian Federation
9 of any part of Ukraine, including any territory taken from
10 Ukraine beginning in 2014 and the results of any

1 referenda sponsored by the Russian Federation that are
2 held within Russian-occupied areas of Ukraine’s Donetsk,
3 Luhansk, Zaporizhzhia, and Kherson regions, does not re-
4 ceive any economic or military assistance from the United
5 States.

6 **SEC. 3. TERMINATION OF FOREIGN ASSISTANCE.**

7 (a) RESTRICTION.—The President shall immediately
8 terminate all economic and military assistance from the
9 United States to any country that recognizes any annex-
10 ation described in section 2 and is prohibited from pro-
11 viding any such assistance to any such country.

12 (b) REPORT.—The President shall—

13 (1) submit a report to Committee on Foreign
14 Relations of the Senate, the Committee on Armed
15 Services of the Senate, the Committee on Appropria-
16 tions of the Senate, the Committee on Foreign Af-
17 fairs of the House of Representatives, the Com-
18 mittee on Armed Services of the House of Rep-
19 resentatives, and the Committee on Foreign Affairs
20 of the House of Representatives that—

21 (A) lists all of the countries that are sub-
22 ject to the restrictions described in subsection
23 (a); and

1 (B) identifies the amount of funding af-
2 fected by such restrictions, disaggregated by
3 country and program; and

4 (2) submit an update of such report to the com-
5 mittees referred to in paragraph (1) whenever a
6 country is added to, or removed from, the list re-
7 ferred to in paragraph (1).

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
