A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to eliminate cost-sharing requirements for behavioral health care under TRICARE Reserve Select.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Affordable Mental
5 Health Care for Selected Reserve Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON COST-SHARING FOR BEHAVIORAL**
7 **HEALTH CARE UNDER TRICARE RESERVE SE-**
8 **LECT.**

9 Section 1076d of title 10, United States Code, is
10 amended—

1 (1) by redesignating subsections (e) and (f) as
2 subsections (f) and (g), respectively; and

3 (2) by inserting after subsection (d) the fol-
4 lowing new subsection (e):

5 “(e) COST-SHARING FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH
6 CARE.—Notwithstanding the cost-sharing requirements
7 under section 1075(e) of this title, a member of a reserve
8 component covered by TRICARE Reserve Select under
9 this section shall not be subject to applicable cost-shares
10 or copayment requirements for any behavioral health care
11 covered under TRICARE Reserve Select.”.

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
