A BILL

To redesignate the National Historic Trails Interpretive Center in Casper, Wyoming, as the “Barbara L. Cubin National Historic Trails Interpretive Center”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF BARBARA L. CUBIN NA-**
4 **TIONAL HISTORIC TRAILS INTERPRETIVE**
5 **CENTER.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The National Historic Trails In-
7 terpretive Center established under section 2(a) of Public
8 Law 105–290 (112 Stat. 2783) in Casper, Wyoming, shall

1 be known and designated as the “Barbara L. Cubin Na-
2 tional Historic Trails Interpretive Center”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the National Historic Trails Interpretive Center
6 referred to in subsection (a) shall be deemed to be a ref-
7 erence to the “Barbara L. Cubin National Historic Trails
8 Interpretive Center”.

9 (c) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 2(a) of
10 Public Law 105–290 (112 Stat. 2783) is amended, in the
11 second sentence, by striking “the National Historic Trails
12 Interpretive Center” and inserting “the ‘Barbara L. Cubin
13 National Historic Trails Interpretive Center’ ”.
