## A BILL

To amend title 18, United States Code, to require a report with respect to delayed notice requirements, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NDO Reporting Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. REPORT RELATING TO DELAYED NOTICE.**

6 Section 2705 of title 18, United States Code, is  
7 amended by adding at the end:

8 “(c) ANNUAL REPORT.—

9 “(1) IN GENERAL.—On an annual basis, the  
10 Attorney General shall provide to the Committee on

1 the Judiciary of the Senate and the Committee on  
2 the Judiciary in the House of Representatives, which  
3 the Attorney General shall publish on the website of  
4 the Department of Justice, in a manner consistent  
5 with the protection of national security, a report set-  
6 ting forth, with respect to the preceding calendar  
7 year, for each Federal judicial district—

8 “(A) the aggregate number of applications  
9 requesting delay of notification pursuant to  
10 subsection (a)(1), preclusion of notice pursuant  
11 to subsection (b), and extensions pursuant to  
12 subsection (a)(4); and

13 “(B) the aggregate number of orders  
14 under this section either granting, extending, or  
15 denying a request for delay of notification or  
16 preclusion of notice.

17 “(2) INCLUSION.—The Attorney General shall  
18 include in the report under this subsection a descrip-  
19 tion of the process and the information used to de-  
20 termine the numbers for each of subparagraphs (A)  
21 and (B) of paragraph (1).”.
