A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF PROHIBITION ON COLLECTIVE**
2 **BARGAINING WITH RESPECT TO COMPENSA-**
3 **TION OF DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-**
4 **FAIRS EMPLOYEES OTHER THAN RATES OF**
5 **BASIC PAY.**

6 Subsections (b) and (d) of section 7422 of title 38,
7 United States Code, are amended by striking “compensa-
8 tion” both places it appears and inserting “rates of basic
9 pay”.
