## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for a presumption of herbicide exposure for certain veterans who served in Korea, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fairness for Korean  
5 DMZ Veterans Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. PRESUMPTION OF HERBICIDE EXPOSURE FOR CER-**  
2 **TAIN VETERANS WHO SERVED IN KOREA.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 11 of title 38, United  
4 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 1116  
5 the following new section:

6 **“§ 1116A. Presumption of herbicide exposure for cer-**  
7 **tain veterans who served in Korea**

8 “(a) PRESUMPTION OF SERVICE-CONNECTION.—(1)  
9 For the purposes of section 1110 of this title, and subject  
10 to section 1113 of this title, a disease specified in sub-  
11 section (b) that becomes manifest as specified in that sub-  
12 section in a veteran described in paragraph (2) shall be  
13 considered to have been incurred or aggravated in the line  
14 of duty in the active military, naval, or air service, not-  
15 withstanding that there is no record of evidence of such  
16 disease during the period of such service.

17 “(2) A veteran described in this paragraph is a vet-  
18 eran who, during active military, naval, or air service,  
19 served in or near the Korean demilitarized zone (DMZ),  
20 during the period beginning on September 1, 1967, and  
21 ending on August 31, 1971.

22 “(b) DISEASES.—A disease specified in this sub-  
23 section is—

24 “(1) a disease specified in paragraph (2) of  
25 subsection (a) of section 1116 of this title that be-  
26 comes manifest as specified in that paragraph; or
