Mr. RUBIO introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Foreign Relations

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## A BILL

To require a determination of whether certain Chinese entities meet the criteria for the imposition of sanctions, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Uyghur Human Rights  
5 Sanctions Review Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF WHETHER CERTAIN CHINESE**  
7 **ENTITIES MEET CRITERIA FOR IMPOSITION**  
8 **OF SANCTIONS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the  
10 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the

1 Treasury, in consultation with the Secretary of State and  
2 the Attorney General, shall—

3 (1) determine whether any entity specified in  
4 subsection (b)—

5 (A) is responsible for or complicit in, or  
6 has directly or indirectly engaged in, serious  
7 human rights abuses against Uyghurs or other  
8 predominantly Muslim ethnic groups in the  
9 Xinjiang Uyghur Autonomous Region of the  
10 People’s Republic of China; or

11 (B) meets the criteria for the imposition of  
12 sanctions under—

13 (i) the Global Magnitsky Human  
14 Rights Accountability Act (22 U.S.C.  
15 10101 et seq.);

16 (ii) section 6 of the Uyghur Human  
17 Rights Policy Act of 2020 (Public Law  
18 116–145; 22 U.S.C. 6901 note);

19 (iii) section 105, 105A, 105B, or  
20 105C of the Comprehensive Iran Sanc-  
21 tions, Accountability, and Divestment Act  
22 of 2010 (22 U.S.C. 8514, 8514a, 8514b,  
23 and 8514c);

24 (iv) Executive Order 13818 (50  
25 U.S.C. 1701 note; relating to blocking the

1 property of persons involved in serious  
2 human rights abuse or corruption), as  
3 amended on or after the date of the enact-  
4 ment of this Act; or

5 (v) Executive Order 13553 (50 U.S.C.  
6 1701 note; relating to blocking property of  
7 certain persons with respect to serious  
8 human rights abuses by the Government of  
9 Iran and taking certain other actions), as  
10 amended on or after the date of the enact-  
11 ment of this Act;

12 (2) if the Secretary of the Treasury determines  
13 under paragraph (1) that an entity is responsible for  
14 or complicit in, or has directly or indirectly engaged  
15 in, serious human rights abuses described in sub-  
16 paragraph (A) of that paragraph or meets the cri-  
17 teria for the imposition of sanctions described in  
18 subparagraph (B) of that paragraph, the Secretary  
19 shall include the entity on the list of specially des-  
20 ignated nationals and blocked persons maintained by  
21 the Office of Foreign Assets Control; and

22 (3) submit to Congress a report on that deter-  
23 mination that includes the reasons for the deter-  
24 mination.

1 (b) ENTITIES SPECIFIED.—An entity specified in this  
2 subsection is any of the following:

3 (1) Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology  
4 Co., Ltd.

5 (2) Shenzhen Huada Gene Technology Co.,  
6 Ltd. (BGI Group).

7 (3) Tiandy Technologies Co., Ltd.

8 (4) Zhejiang Dahua Technology Co., Ltd.

9 (5) China Electronics Technology Group Co.

10 (6) Zhejiang Uniview Technologies Co., Ltd.

11 (7) Alibaba Group Holding, Ltd.

12 (8) Baidu, Inc.

13 (9) ByteDance Ltd.

14 (10) China TransInfo Technology Co., Ltd.

15 (c) FORM OF REPORT.—The report required by sub-  
16 section (a)(3) shall be submitted in unclassified form, but  
17 may include a classified annex.

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
