A BILL

To double the existing penalties for the provision of misleading or inaccurate caller identification information.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Anti-Spoofing Pen-
5 alties Modernization Act of 2021”.

1 **SEC. 2. INCREASING PENALTIES FOR SPOOFERS.**

2 Section 227(e)(5) of the Communications Act of
3 1934 (47 U.S.C. 227(e)(5)) is amended—

4 (1) in subparagraph (A)(i)—

5 (A) by striking “\$10,000” and inserting
6 “\$20,000”; and

7 (B) by striking “\$1,000,000” and insert-
8 ing “\$2,000,000”; and

9 (2) in subparagraph (B), by striking “\$10,000”
10 and inserting “\$20,000”.
