## A BILL

To provide for special rules relating to assistance concerning  
the Greensburg, Kansas tornado.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Greensburg, Kansas  
5 Recovery Extension Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS TO ADDRESS GREENS-**  
7 **BURG, KANSAS TORNADO.**

8 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in the  
9 case of any national emergency grant that was made  
10 under section 173 of the Workforce Investment Act of

1 1998 (29 U.S.C. 2918) to address the effects of the May  
2 4, 2007, Greensburg, Kansas tornado, funds made avail-  
3 able for such grant shall remain available for expenditure  
4 through June 30, 2010.
