## A BILL

To authorize the location of a monument on the National Mall to commemorate and honor the women’s suffrage movement and the passage of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Women’s Suffrage Na-  
5 tional Monument Location Act”

1 **SEC. 2. WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE NATIONAL MONUMENT.**

2 (a) SITE.—Notwithstanding section 8908(c) of title  
3 40, United States Code, the Women's Suffrage National  
4 Monument shall be located within the Reserve.

5 (b) APPLICABILITY OF COMMEMORATIVE WORKS  
6 ACT.—Except as provided in subsection (a), chapter 89  
7 of title 40, United States Code (commonly known as the  
8 “Commemorative Works Act”), shall apply to the Wom-  
9 en's Suffrage National Monument.

10 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

11 (1) WOMEN'S SUFFRAGE NATIONAL MONU-  
12 MENT.—The term “Women's Suffrage National  
13 Monument” means the commemorative work author-  
14 ized to be established under Public Law 116–217  
15 (40 U.S.C. 8903 note).

16 (2) RESERVE.—The term “Reserve” has the  
17 meaning given such term in section 8902(a)(3) of  
18 title 40, United States Code.
