Mr. VITTER introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Environment and Public Works

A BILL

To amend the Migratory Bird Treaty Act to authorize hunting under certain circumstances.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Migratory Bird Treaty
5 Amendment Act of 2013”.

6 **SEC. 2. MIGRATORY BIRDS.**

7 Section 3 of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (16
8 U.S.C. 704) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
9 lowing:

1 “(c) EXCEPTION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
2 sion of this Act, subsection (b) shall not apply to an agri-
3 cultural producer, or a hunter with the permission of the
4 agricultural producer, if—

5 “(1) the manipulation occurs on land of the ag-
6 ricultural producer on which a crop during the cur-
7 rent or immediately preceding crop year was not
8 harvestable due to a natural disaster, as determined
9 by the Secretary of Agriculture; and

10 “(2) a local representative of the Secretary of
11 Agriculture confirms that—

12 “(A) the crop has been destroyed; and

13 “(B) it would not be economically prac-
14 ticable to harvest the crop.”.

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
