CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Expressing the sense of Congress on the use of the Intergovernmental Personnel Act Mobility Program and the Department of Defense Information Technology Exchange Program to obtain personnel with cyber skills and abilities for the Department of Defense.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This concurrent resolution may be cited as the
5 “Whole of Society Cyber Personnel Cooperation Resolu-
6 tion of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS ON USE OF INTERGOVERN-**
2 **MENTAL PERSONNEL ACT MOBILITY PRO-**
3 **GRAM AND DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE IN-**
4 **FORMATION TECHNOLOGY EXCHANGE PRO-**
5 **GRAM TO OBTAIN PERSONNEL WITH CYBER**
6 **SKILLS AND ABILITIES FOR THE DEPART-**
7 **MENT OF DEFENSE.**

8 It is the sense of Congress that—

9 (1) the Department of Defense should fully use
10 the Intergovernmental Personnel Act Mobility Pro-
11 gram (IPAMP) and the Department of Defense In-
12 formation Technology Exchange Program (ITEP) to
13 obtain cyber personnel across the Government by
14 leveraging cyber capabilities found at the State and
15 local government level and in the private sector in
16 order to meet the needs of the Department for cy-
17 bersecurity professionals; and

18 (2) the Department should implement at the
19 earliest practicable date a strategy that includes
20 policies and plans to fully use such programs to ob-
21 tain such personnel for the Department.

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
