## JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia of certain defense articles and services.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That the following proposed foreign military sale to the  
4       Kingdom of Saudi Arabia is prohibited:

5               (1) The sale of the following defense articles  
6               and services, described in Transmittal No. 24–43,  
7               submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)  
8               of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.  
9               2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional  
10              Record on July 29, 2024: follow-on logistics support

1 and services, including for Joint Mission Planning  
2 Software (JMPS) hardware and support; KIV-77/78  
3 cryptographic devices and support; spares and repair  
4 parts, consumables and accessories, and repair and  
5 return support; calibration support and test equip-  
6 ment; ground and personnel equipment; classified  
7 and unclassified software and software support, clas-  
8 sified and unclassified publications and technical  
9 documentation; personnel training and training  
10 equipment; U.S. Government and contractor engi-  
11 neering, technical, and logistics support services; and  
12 other related elements of logistics and program sup-  
13 port, in support of, but not limited to, KC-130J, C-  
14 130, E-3, RE-3, KE-3, KA 350, Bell 212, and Bell  
15 412 aircraft.
