## JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of Israel of certain defense articles and services.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       That the following proposed foreign military sale to the  
4       Government of Israel is prohibited:

5               (1) The sale of the following defense articles  
6               and services described in Transmittal No. 24–01,  
7               submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)  
8               of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.  
9               2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional  
10              Record on September 10, 2024: Up to fifty (50) F–

1 15IA aircraft; one hundred twenty (120) F110-GE-  
2 129 engines; ninety (90) Advanced Display Core  
3 Processors II; seventy-five (75) APG-82(V)1 Active  
4 Electronically Scanned Array radars; fifty (50) AN/  
5 AAQ-13 LANTIRN navigation pods with con-  
6 tainers; three-hundred twenty (320) LAU-128 Ad-  
7 vanced Medium Range Air-to-Air Missile launchers;  
8 twenty-five (25) M61A Vulcan Cannons; and one  
9 hundred eighty (180) Embedded Global Positioning  
10 System/Inertial Navigation System devices with M-  
11 Code. Also included are Cartridge Actuated Devices  
12 and Propellant Actuated Devices; Joint Helmet  
13 Mounted Cueing Systems; APX-119 Identification  
14 Friend or Foe (IFF) systems; KIV-77 Mode 4/5  
15 IFF cryptographic appliques; AN/PYQ-10 Simple  
16 Key Loaders; impulse cartridges, chaff, and flares;  
17 integration and test support and equipment; aircraft  
18 and munitions support and support equipment; se-  
19 cure communications equipment, precision naviga-  
20 tion, and cryptographic devices; classified software  
21 development, delivery, and support; spare parts,  
22 consumables and accessories, and repair and return  
23 support; major and minor modifications, mainte-  
24 nance, and maintenance support; facilities and con-  
25 struction support; transportation and airlift support;

1       classified publications and technical documentation;  
2       personnel training and training equipment; warran-  
3       ties; studies and surveys; U.S. Government and con-  
4       tractor engineering, technical, and logistics support  
5       services; and other related elements of logistics and  
6       program support.
