**JOINT RESOLUTION**

Providing for an exception to the limitation on the appointment of certain persons as the United States Trade Representative.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. EXCEPTION TO LIMITATION ON APPOINTMENT**  
4                       **OF CERTAIN PERSONS AS UNITED STATES**  
5                       **TRADE REPRESENTATIVE.**

6       (a) IN GENERAL.—The limitation under section  
7       141(b)(4) of the Trade Act of 1974 (19 U.S.C.  
8       2171(b)(4)) shall not apply to the first person appointed,

1 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, as the  
2 United States Trade Representative after the date of the  
3 enactment of this joint resolution, if that person served  
4 as a Deputy United States Trade Representative before  
5 the date of the enactment of the Lobbying Disclosure Act  
6 of 1995 (2 U.S.C. 1601 et seq.).

7 (b) LIMITED EXCEPTION.—This section applies only  
8 to the first person appointed as United States Trade Rep-  
9 resentative after the date of the enactment of this joint  
10 resolution, and to no other person.
