## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States relative to limiting the number of terms that a Member of Congress may serve.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*  
3       *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein),* That the fol-  
4       lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-  
5       stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all  
6       intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when  
7       ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several  
8       States within seven years after the date of its submission  
9       by the Congress:



1 year between such consecutive terms and the subsequent  
2 term.

3       “SECTION 3. No term of service beginning before the  
4 date of the ratification of this article shall be taken into  
5 account in determining eligibility for election or appoint-  
6 ment under this article.”.
