referred to the Committee on Energy and Natural Resources

## JOINT RESOLUTION

Redesignating the Robert E. Lee Memorial in Arlington National  
Cemetery as the “Arlington House National Historic Site”.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3       That—

4               (1) the site administered by the National Park  
5       Service and dedicated as a memorial to Robert E.  
6       Lee pursuant to the joint resolution of June 29,  
7       1955 (Public Law 84–107; 69 Stat. 190), as amend-  
8       ed by the joint resolution of June 30, 1972 (Public  
9       Law 92–333; 86 Stat. 401), shall after the date of  
10       the enactment of this joint resolution be redesign-

1 nated and known as the “Arlington House National  
2 Historic Site”;

3 (2) any reference in any law, regulation, map,  
4 document, paper, or other record of the United  
5 States to the site referred to in paragraph (1) shall  
6 be considered to be a reference to the Arlington  
7 House National Historic Site; and

8 (3) the joint resolution of June 29, 1955 (Pub-  
9 lic Law 84–107; 69 Stat. 190), and the joint resolu-  
10 tion of June 30, 1972 (Public Law 92–333; 86 Stat.  
11 401), are repealed.
