## JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the Government of the United Arab Emirates of certain defense articles and services.

1        *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2        *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3        That the following proposed foreign military sale to the  
4        Government of the United Arab Emirates is prohibited:  
5                (1) The sale of the following defense articles  
6                and services, described in Transmittal No. 22–32,  
7                submitted to Congress pursuant to section 36(b)(1)  
8                of the Arms Export Control Act (22 U.S.C.  
9                2776(b)(1)), and published in the Congressional

1 Record on August 2, 2022: ninety-six (96) Terminal  
2 High Altitude Area Defense (THAAD) missile  
3 rounds; two (2) THAAD Launch Control Stations  
4 (LCS); and two (2) THAAD Tactical Operations  
5 Stations (TOS); Repair and return, system integra-  
6 tion and checkout, and spare and repair parts; sup-  
7 port and testing equipment; publications and tech-  
8 nical documentation; construction activities;  
9 encryption devices; secure communication equip-  
10 ment; other required COMSEC equipment; and  
11 other related elements of logistical and program sup-  
12 port.
