SANITATION AMENDMENTS

Representative **James A. Dunnigan** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 11 through 20:*

- 11 This bill:
- 12 ▶ defines terms;
- 13 ▶ requires a local health department to create an informational notice if the local
- 14 health department does not annually inspect commercial cosmetology facilities;
- 15 ▶ requires a commercial cosmetology facility to post an informational notice in a visible area;
- 16 ▶ authorizes a local health department to impose a fine for a commercial cosmetology facility's
- 17 failure to comply with the informational notice requirement;
- 18 ▶ requires the Division of Occupational and Professional Licensing to inform licensed
- 19 individuals of the requirement to post a notice in a commercial cosmetology facility; and
- 20 ▶ makes technical changes.

2. *Page 2, Line 41:*

- 41 (2) " ~~{Cosmetology}~~ Commercial cosmetology facility" means a facility where an individual
practices or instructs:
