Representative Ryan D. Wilcox proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 11 through 16:
  - 11 This bill:
  - amends driver license suspension for certain drug related offenses to {-offenses
  - 13 involving the controlled substance or paraphernalia in the passenger compartment of
  - 14 the vehicle circumstances in which the court finds that a driver license suspension is likely to reduce recidivism and is in the interest of public safety;
  - removes driver license suspension requirements for certain offenses related to
  - 16 custodial interference; and
- 2. Page 4, Lines 91 through 96:
  - 91 receiving a record of conviction, the division shall immediately suspend for six months the
  - 92 license of the convicted person if the person was convicted of one of the following offenses
  - 93 while the person was an operator of a motor vehicle, and the court finds that { the substance or
  - 94 <u>paraphernalia was found in the passenger compartment of the motor vehicle</u>} a <u>driver license</u> suspension is likely to reduce recidivism and is in the interest of public safety:
  - 95 (i) any violation of:
  - 96 (A) Title 58, Chapter 37, Utah Controlled Substances Act;
