Enactment of this legislation could cost the Department of Public Safety \$1,671,000 one-time from the General Fund in FY25 to provide the grants to local education agencies as outlined in the bill.

Enactment of this bill could cost the Department of Public Safety \$634,500 in ongoing expenses from the General Fund beginning in FY25 for annual trainings and administration of the Educator Protect Program as outlined in the bill.
