This bill appropriates \$375,000 one-time from the Education Fund in FY 2018 to the State Board of Education for the two-year Early Warning Pilot Program. Of the total appropriation, \$125,000 one-time is to the State Board of Education for enhancement of the online data reporting tool and \$250,000 onetime is for 50% of the cost for a local education agency to access the digital program which is matched at 50% by local education agencies.
