Enactment of this legislation could reduce the year-end transfer to the General Fund, from the Commerce Service Fund, by \$6,900 annually and \$2,300 one-time beginning in FY 2018.

Local Government

UCA 36-12-13(2)(c)

Enactment of this legislation likely will not result in direct, measurable costs for local governments.

Individuals & Businesses

UCA 36-12-13(2)(d)

Enactment of this bill could increase costs for businesses or security personnel as a result of the additional education requirements required in the bill. An additional 24 hours of classroom or online curriculum for licensees would be required. Total cost is unknown but the minimum estimated cost per hour is \$10 per individual.

Notes on Notes

Fiscal notes estimate the direct costs or revenues of enacting a bill. The Legislature uses them to balance the budget. They do not measure a bill's benefits or non-fiscal impacts like opportunity costs, wait times, or inconvenience. A fiscal note is not an appropriation. The Legislature decides appropriations separately.
