7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9 This bill allows certain parties to enter into an interlocal agreement that extends beyond
10 a maximum term requirement.

22 **11-13-216**, as last amended by Laws of Utah 2003, Chapter 38

24 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

25 Section 1. Section **11-13-216** is amended to read:

26 **11-13-216. Term of agreements.**

27 (1) Except as provided in [~~Subsection~~] Subsections (2) and 11-13-204(3), each
28 agreement under this chapter shall extend for a term [~~of~~] not to exceed 50 years.

29 (2) Subsection (1) does not apply to an agreement to which:

- 30 (a) a project entity is a party;
- 31 (b) an electric interlocal entity is a party; or
- 32 (c) an energy services interlocal entity is a party.
