LONG TITLE

ENACTS:

76-6-202.2, as Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **76-6-202.2** is enacted to read:

76-6-202.2 . Interruption of a connected service in the commission of a burglary.

(1) (a) As used in this section:

(i) "Burglary" means an offense under Section 76-6-202.

(ii) "Connected service" means electrical, Internet, or telephone service.

(b) Terms defined in Sections 76-1-101.5 and 76-6-201 apply to this section.

(2) An actor commits interruption of a connected service in the commission of a burglary if,

29 in attempting, committing, or fleeing from a burglary, the actor knowingly damages,
30 disables, or interrupts a connected service.

31 (3) A violation of Subsection (2) is a third degree felony.

32 Section 2. **Effective date.**

33 This bill takes effect on May 1, 2024.
