Veterinarian-client-patient relationship. 21 (1) [A](a) Except as provided in Subsection (1)(b), a licensee under this chapter may only 22 23 practice under a veterinarian-client-patient relationship as defined in Section 24 58-28-102. 25 (b) Notwithstanding Section 58-28-102, when a veterinarian employed by the 26 Department of Agriculture and Food issues a prescription to an apis mellifera owner, 27 a veterinarian-client-patient relationship is established for the veterinarian employed 28 by the Department of Agriculture and Food if: 29 (i) the relevant apiary is inspected by: (A) a county bee inspector, employed under Section 4-11-105; or 30 31 (B) an inspector for the Department of Agriculture and Food; and

32	(ii) in conducting the inspection under Subsection (1)(b)(i), the inspector works in
33	conjunction with the veterinarian employed by the Department of Agriculture and

35	(2) A veterinarian-client-patient relationship may not be established solely by telephone or
36	other electronic means.
37	Section 2. Effective date.
38	This bill takes effect on May 7, 2025.
