7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9 This bill modifies the Transportation Code by amending provisions relating to the
10 divisions of the Department of Transportation.

11 **Highlighted Provisions:**

12 This bill:

- 13 ▶ repeals the Administrative Services Division of the Department of Transportation;
- 14 ▶ changes the name of the Community Relations Division to the Communications
15 Division and modifies the responsibilities of that division;
- 16 ▶ provides that the Program Development Division is responsible for:
- 17 • maintaining and operating the asset management systems; and
- 18 • providing research services associated with transportation programs;
- 19 ▶ repeals the requirement that the Project Development Division is responsible for
20 performing research into materials and methods for construction of state
21 transportation systems;
- 22 ▶ provides that the Operations Division is responsible for procuring administrative
23 supplies and equipment and risk management; and
- 24 ▶ makes technical corrections.
