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**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill modifies Title 23, Wildlife Resources Code of Utah, Chapter 19, Licenses, Permits, and Tags.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

▸ requires the Wildlife Board to prescribe the term and expiration date for a license, permit, or certificate of registration issued under Title 23, Wildlife Resources Code of Utah;

▸ amends the terms of fishing licenses; and

▸ makes technical changes.

29 **23-19-7. Expiration date of licenses, permits, and certificates of registration.**

30 ~~[The licenses]~~ (1) The Wildlife Board shall prescribe the term and expiration date for  
31 licenses, permits, and certificates of registration issued under this [chapter] title, except lifetime  
32 licenses~~[, will expire 365 days from the date of issue].~~

33 (2) The effective date and expiration date, if any, of a license, permit, or certificate of  
34 registration shall be indicated on the license, permit, or certificate of registration.

35 Section 2. Section 23-19-21 is amended to read:

36 **23-19-21. Fishing license.**

37 (1) A person 12 years of age or older shall purchase a fishing license before engaging  
38 in any regulated fishing activity.

39 (2) ~~[A person 12 years of age or older, upon]~~ After paying the fee prescribed by the  
40 Wildlife Board, a person may obtain a license to fish~~[:] and, after the license is granted, engage~~  
41 in fishing according to the rules, proclamations, and orders of the Wildlife Board.

44 ~~[(c) for 365 consecutive days from the date of sale.]~~
