24	Section 1. Section 76-9-109 is enacted to read:
25	76-9-109. Targeted residential picketing.
26	(1) As used in this section:
27	(a) "Picketing" means the stationing or posting of one or more individuals to apprise

28	the public, vocally or by standing or marching with signs, banners, sound amplification
29	devices, or other means, of an opinion or a message.
30	(b) "Residence" means any single-family, duplex, or multi-family dwelling unit that is
31	not being used as a targeted occupant's sole place of business or as a place of public meeting.
32	(c) "Targeted residential picketing" means picketing, with or without signs, that is
33	specifically directed or focused toward a residence, or one or more occupants of the residence,
34	and that takes place:
35	(i) on that portion of a sidewalk or street in front of the residence, in front of an
36	adjoining residence, or on either side of the targeted residence; or
37	(ii) within 100 feet of the property line of the targeted residence.
38	(2) It is unlawful to engage in targeted residential picketing.
39	(3) This section does not apply to:
40	(a) an individual picketing at the individual's own residence;
41	(b) the picketing of a meeting place or assembly area commonly used to discuss
42	subjects of general public interest; or
43	(c) general picketing that proceeds through residential neighborhoods or that proceeds
44	past residences.
45	(4) Targeted residential picketing is a class B misdemeanor.
