LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends provisions related to local government curfews.

10-8-84.6, Utah Code Annotated 1953

17-50-339, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **10-8-84.6** is enacted to read:

10-8-84.6. Prohibition on ordinances imposing curfews on minors.

(1) For purposes of this section, "minor" means an individual under 18 years old.



28 (2) A municipality may not enact or enforce an ordinance that imposes a curfew on
29 minors between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

30 Section 2. Section **17-50-339** is enacted to read:

31 **17-50-339. Prohibition on ordinances imposing curfews on minors.**

32 (1) For purposes of this section, "minor" means an individual under 18 years old.

33 (2) A county may not enact or enforce an ordinance that imposes a curfew on minors
34 between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.
