LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill ensures payment of an online course fee for students attending small schools.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53F-4-518** is enacted to read:

53F-4-518. Small school student access to college and career readiness courses.

27 (3), in lieu of a deduction described in Subsection [53F-4-507](#)(2), the state board shall use funds
28 from an appropriation for the Statewide Online Education Program to pay for an online course
29 fee described in Section [53F-4-505](#) for a student who is enrolled in a public high school that
30 enrolls fewer than 1,000 students.
