This bill creates a reimbursement for a local education agency student information system.

ENACTS:

53F-7-202, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53F-7-202** is enacted to read:

53F-7-202. Reimbursement for local student information systems.

(1) As used in this section, "student information system" means a computer database that provides:



- 28 (a) academic intervention tracking;
- 29 (b) assessment imports;
- 30 (c) attendance tracking;
- 31 (d) college and career tracking;
- 32 (e) food service data;
- 33 (f) notification of student academic summary information;
- 34 (g) scheduling;
- 35 (h) teacher grade books; or
- 36 (i) daily submission of information for state and federal reporting.
- 37 (2) Subject to legislative appropriations, an LEA that uses a student information system
- 38 developed by the LEA or an entity other than the state board may request from the state board
- 39 an annual reimbursement, subject to Subsection (3), for the cost of the LEA's student
- 40 information system.
- 41 (3) If an LEA requests a reimbursement under Subsection (2), the state board shall
- 42 reimburse an LEA \$5.00 for each student enrolled in the LEA.
